What is the SOPHIE program?

- **SOPHIE** - *Southern Ontario Pharmaceutical and Health Innovation Ecosystem*
- 3-year program funded through the Federal Economic Development Agency of Southern Ontario (FedDev)

- Total funding envelope = \$4.5 million for collaborative commercialization/scaling projects with academic/clinical champions



- Each project can leverage up to \$100,000 in non-dilutive funding to support a commercialization/scaling project.

Company Eligibility



Be a Canadian incorporated company, with operation primarily based in Ontario



Be working on innovation relevant to the life sciences sector



Be developing an innovative technology at the TRL-6 or above



Identified a principal investigator/clinical champion at the academic or clinical partner institution where the project will take place.

Types of Eligible Projects

Clinical Trial

Obtain data from human subjects on the efficacy of your technology/product.



Scaling Project

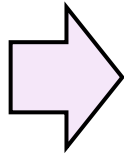
Develop methods to increase efficacy of technology/product through minimal additional outputs.



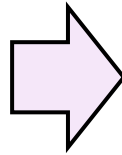
Sectors of innovation include medical devices, pharmaceutical/therapeutic interventions and digital health technologies.

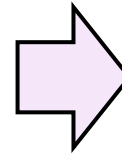

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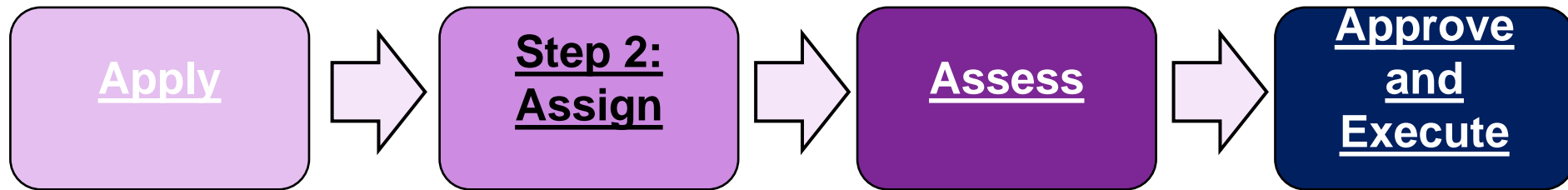

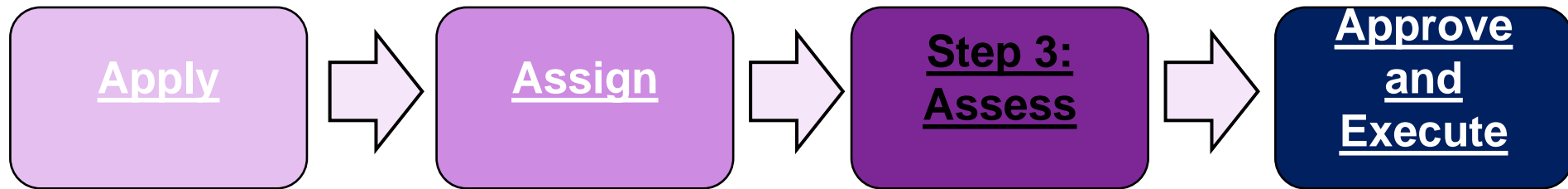

Application Process – Step 3




Proposal defines project activities:

1. What are the commercialization project activities and milestones?
2. How does the impact of the project accelerate the business' commercialization activities?

- Application + Proposal is assessed by the SOPHIE Team
- Decision Notification: ~2 weeks
- Feedback will be provided to companies to improve project outcomes

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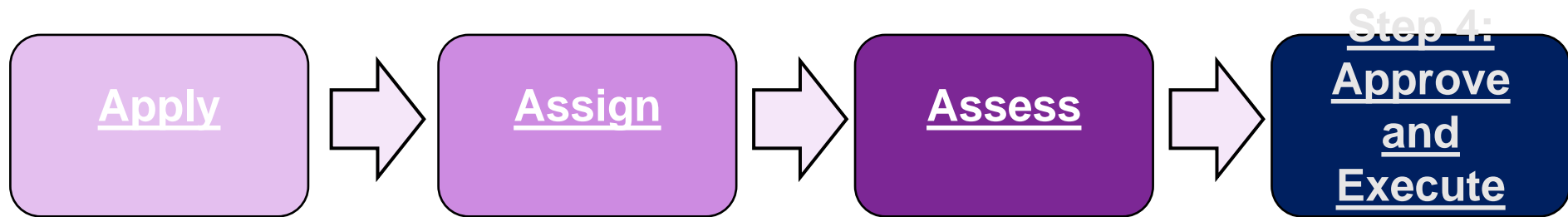

Application Process – Step 4



- Drafting and legal review of contract between life science company, academic/clinical institution and Innovation Factory.
- Signatures from all three parties on the approved contract.
- Begin execution of the project.
