- Riya Karumanchi, 14 year old entrepreneur
- Cane enhanced with Internet of Things technology so that it could detect objects at waist level and warn the user
- has been supported by the Mohawk MEDIC lab, the University of Toronto Creative Destruction Lab, and the Ryerson University DMZ Accelerator to develop the SmartCane into a startup funded by the likes of Microsoft, raising more than \$50,000
